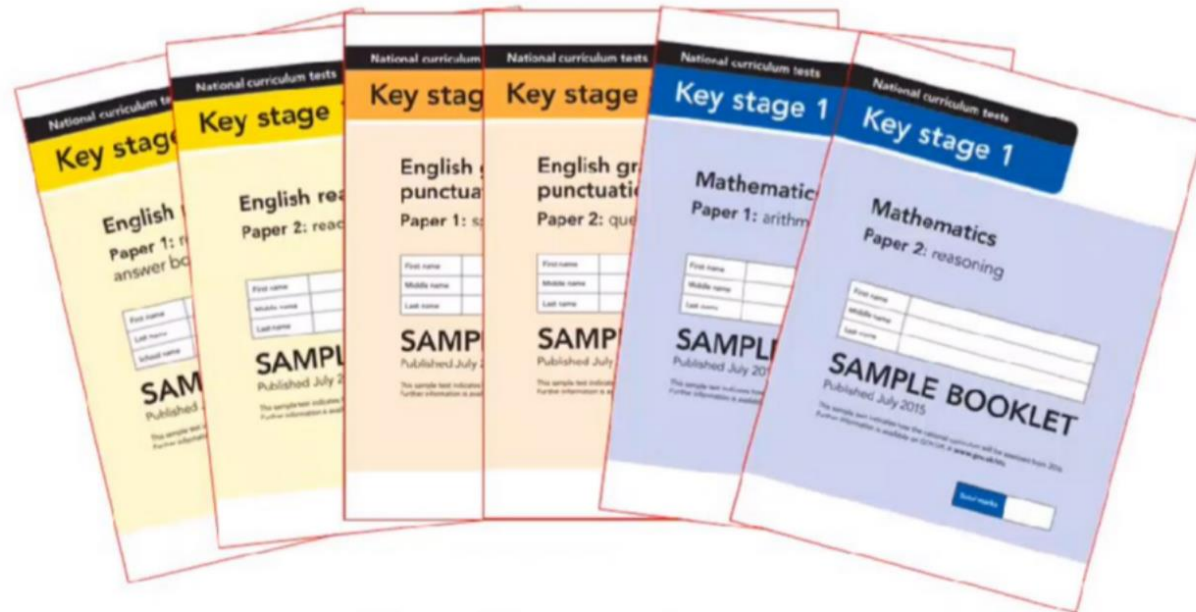


Key Stage 1 SATS

- Take place in Summer term each year.
- For our children they will take place from 8th to 12th June 2026.
- It is important that all children are in school during this time.
- Children undertake the tests in small groups with their teacher.
- In school we will refer to the tests as booklets – often the children don't even realise they are doing test, so please do not worry!

Reporting SATS results and Teacher Assessment

- At the end of the year school reports all teacher assessment and test results to the LA.
 - Your child will receive an overall teacher assessment for Reading, Writing and Mathematics.
 - This will take into consideration the tests results as well as all the work and evidence in your child's book.

Key Stage 1 tests

Writing – Teacher Assessment

Children do not undertake a test for Writing.

- The children's writing in their books are teacher assessed against the Year 2 standards for writing.

Spelling and Spelling Common Exception Words

Children are expected to read and spell a list of common exception words. These words will be tested throughout the year.

Support at home

Throughout this year some children may be asked to take part in booster sessions.

They should access TTRockstars and weekly spellings practise.

The most important thing children will be asked to do is read to their grown-ups daily.
