Key Knowledge:

In France, primary school children don't go to school on Wednesday.

There are two words for 'the' in French : le and la.

There are two words for 'a' in French: un and une.

With **plural** nouns they become : les and des

When you ask a question in French, raise the pitch of your voice at end of the question, this is called **intonation**.

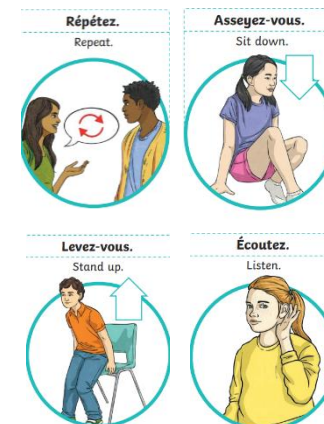
