Neil Armstrong was the first human to walk on the moon during the NASA (National Aeronautics and Space Administration) Apollo 11 mission on 20th July 1969. He completed the mission alongside copilots Edwin E. "Buzz" Aldrin and Michael Collins.

Explore – to travel across or through in order to discover or search for something

Navigation – the act of setting a course for or controlling a ship or aircraft

Voyage - a long journey by air, land, sea, or outer space

Discovery – the act of discovering/finding something for the first time.

Toy - An object for a child to play with, typically a model or miniature replica of something

Electronic toy – A toy which uses electricity to function

Clockwork toy – A toy which uses clockwork technology to function

Past – Gone by in time. The time before the moment

Present – Existing or occurring now

Now – At the present time or moment

Then – At the time in question

Old - Made or built long ago

New – Produced recently or for the first time, not existing before

Museum - A building in which objects of historical, scientific, artistic, or cultural interest are

stored and exhibited
