Key Vocabulary

Past – Gone by in time and no longer existing.

Present- Existing or occurring now.

Holiday- An extending period of leisure, especially spent away from home.

Seaside – A place by the sea.

Beach- A beach is a landform alongside a body of water.

Human feature- A man made part of a geographical area.

Physical feature – A natural part of a geographical area.

Harbour - A place on the coast where ships may moor in shelter.

Pier- A pier is a raised structure that rises above a body of water and usually just out from its shore.

Cliff- A high area of rock with a very steep side, often on a coast.
