### Key Vocabulary

**Past** – Gone by in time and no longer existing.

**Present**- Existing or occurring now.

**Holiday**- An extending period of leisure, especially spent away from home.

**Seaside** – A place by the sea.

**Beach**- A beach is a landform alongside a body of water.

**Human feature**- A man made part of a geographical area.

**Physical feature** – A natural part of a geographical area.

**Harbour** - A place on the coast where ships may moor in shelter.

**Pier**- A pier is a raised structure that rises above a body of water and usually just out from its shore.

**Cliff**- A high area of rock with a very steep side, often on a coast.

**Map**- A representation of an area of land/sea showing physical features.

**Compass**- A magnetized pointer which shows the direction of magnetic north.

**Direction**- A course along which someone/ something moves or faces.
