Language of position	Describe movement
<p>The <u>circle</u> is to the right of the square. The <u>triangle</u> is to the left of the circle.</p>	<p>Draw an X to show where the counter would be if it moved <u>1 square right</u>.</p>

Describe turns	Shape patterns with turns
<p>Which way has the lollipop turned?</p> <p>The lollipop has completed a <u>quarter</u> turn <u>anticlockwise</u>.</p>	

Key Vocabulary	
Coordinates	A pair of numbers that show the exact position of a point on a grid.
Direction	The way someone or something is facing or moving, like left, right, forwards, or backwards.
Follow	To move along a route or path in the same order as shown.
Half turn	Turning around so you face the opposite direction (180°).
Left	The direction opposite of right.
Right	The direction opposite of left.
Quarter turn	Turning a quarter of a circle (90°).
