Inspired by books, museum exhibits ad botanical gardens he created dreamlike images filled with lush plants, exotic animals and mysterious landscapes. His style, known as Naïve Art or Primitivism, features bold colours, simple shapes and a unique use of layering to create depth. Rousseau's paintings like 'The Sleeping Gypsy' and 'Tiger in a Tropical Storm' inspire young artists to explore imaginative settings and experiment with composition, colour and texture in their own work.
