<p>Key Knowledge:</p> <p>In English hair is a singular noun and in French “hair” is a plural noun (les cheveux).</p> <p>There are two words for “the” in French with singular nouns.</p> <p>These words are “le” and “la”</p> <p>There is only one word for “the” with French plural nouns and this is “les”.</p>
