Key Vocabulary and Glossary


Green Screen - A technique that allows filmmakers to replace a solid green background

- with any image or video, giving the illusion of being somewhere else. **Crop** The action of cutting off unwanted parts of a video or image to focus on a specific
- **Crop** The action of cutting off unwanted parts of a video or image to focus on a specific area.
- Resize Changing the dimensions of a video or image to make it larger or smaller.
- Script A written text that outlines what will be said or done in a video or presentation.
- **Editing** The process of selecting and arranging video shots to create a sequence or narrative.
- Transition A technique used to move from one scene to another, such as fades or cuts.
- Clip A short segment of video.
- Publish Making the final video available for others to watch, typically by sharing online.
- Share To distribute the final video project with others through various platforms.

- The green screen technique has been used in Hollywood films since the 1930s.
- iMovie was first launched in 1999 and has evolved significantly with each update, adding new features and capabilities.
- A well-crafted script can enhance storytelling and engage your audience more effectively.
- Video content is known to be one of the most consumed forms of media online today, making video editing skills highly valuable.
