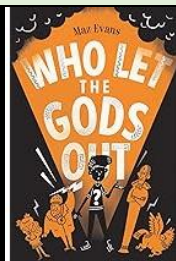
Selection of Non-Fiction examples of tourist information

Tone – formal, persuasive



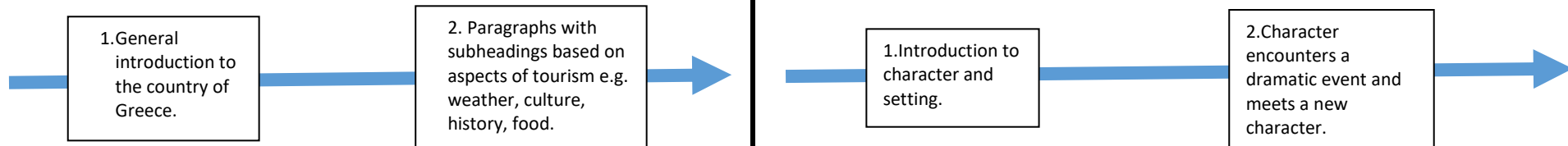
Who Let the Gods Out by Maz Evans
