Key facts to remember

- In ancient Greece, vases were important due to their functional and symbolic roles in everyday life, rituals, and religious practices.
- The vases were used for storage, carrying, mixing, and serving liquids like wine and water, as well as holding perfumes and cosmetics.
- Vases also served as vessels for storytelling, visual representation of mythology, and expressions of artistic and cultural identity.

Ancient Greece

Ancient Greece was a civilization in the north eastern Mediterranean, spanning from the Greek Dark Ages.

Vase

A decorative container typically made of glass or china and used as an ornament or for displaying cut flowers.

Design criteria

The explicit goals that a project must achieve in order to be successful.

Annotated sketches

A drawing that includes notes and explanations.

Evaluate

To judge how good or bad something is.
