

<p>Like or Dislike?</p> <p>To say you like a sport in French, you can say: "J'aime le football" (I like football). If you want to say you dislike a sport, say: "Je n'aime pas le tennis" (I do not like tennis). You can add "parce que" (because) to explain why. For example: "J'aime le football parce que c'est amusant" (I like football because it is fun). Or "Je n'aime pas le tennis parce que c'est ennuyeux" (I do not like tennis because it is boring). Remember to use "J'aime" for liking and "Je n'aime pas" for disliking!</p>
