God made our beautiful world and everything in it.




people Bible stewardship

Lesson Nine and Ten

'In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.'



The prayer starts with the right hand on the forehead. For Christians, this is a reminder that God, the Father, created the world.



The hand moves down towards the earth.

This is a reminder that Jesus, the Son of God became a man.

The right hand moves from the left shoulder to the right shoulder.



The hand travels across your heart, where Christians believe God's Holy Spirit helps us to be kind.



Then the hand travels to both shoulders, as a reminder that God wraps everyone in love.

When some Christian families have a new baby, they want the baby to meet God. There is a special name for this meeting –

the **Sacrament of Baptism.** When a baby is baptised, they are part of the Christian family, God's family, as well as part of their family (parents, brothers, sisters etc.).









- 1. The family takes the baby to church for a special service. Usually, they invite friends and people who also go to church will come along to welcome the baby. The priest will welcome everyone and say prayers.
- 2. The most important part of the baptism is when the priest says the baby's name and makes the sign of the cross.
- 3. Then pours water over the baby's head three times as he says, Father, Son, and Spirit. The children should recognise the words of the Sign of the Cross.
- 4. Family and friends pray for the baby. They have brought their baby to this meeting point with God.

The Sign of the Cross Prayer Christian

Welcome gift water family Baptism



This is a family. Friends can also feel like family.

We use water when we are thirsty. We use water to stay clean. Water is a gift of God's creation.

The priest pours water as a sign of life, a baby is newly born as a Christian. Baptism day is like a second birthday, a day when life as a Christian begins. Water is a sign of washing away the past and starting a new life so the first prayer the priest says are the words of the sign of the cross, wrapping the baby in God's love.



Everyone is invited to be part of God's family. The Bible tells us Christians that God the Father has loved us so much. He loved us so much that we are called children of God.
